Care for patients with the latest updates on your patient panel



## The Notifications solution sends alerts of patient test results, emergency department visits and/or hospital admissions or discharges.

Having accurate, timely clinical data at the point of care helps inform clinical decisions, enables more timely outreach and enhances the patient experience. With Notifications, practices receive real-time or daily alerts when a patient has new lab results, has visited an ER or has been admitted or discharged from a hospital and more. As a result, practices can improve care management, reduce hospital readmissions, enhance disease management programs and inform quality improvement programs.

In addition to the ADT Notifications, CORHIO can notify your practice of lab results via daily batched reports, real-time electronic interface, or real-time delivery into a care management system, and include the following:

- Diabetes—results including Hemoglobin A1C
- Cholesterol—results from lipid panels, including Total Cholesterol, High-Density Lipoprotein Cholesterol (HDL-C), Low-Density Lipoprotein Cholesterol (LDL-C), and Triglycerides
- Hepatitis—results from hepatitis panel, including A, B and C and antibody results
- COVID-19—results from molecular (RT-PCR) test

## Supports High-Risk Patient Management

Receiving notifications of patient information is critical for effectively managing patients who are part of risk-based arrangements or care management programs.

## Enhances Care Management

Practice teams can quickly reach out to patients to schedule follow-up office visits and to coordinate transitions of care. Practices can use these efforts to increase reimbursements—including Medicare Transitional Care Management services.

## Informs Reporting for Value-Based Contracts

With a complete view of patient medical history and the ability for more timely patient outreach, reporting for value-based contracts or quality programs becomes faster and more effective.
