


Accessing Care Summaries in PatientCare 360®

The Documents tab displays all Care Summaries associated with your patient in the CORHIO health information exchange network. The workflow to access Care Summaries from community providers, Kaiser Permanente, Department of Defense, Veteran’s Administration and Quality Health Network is different because CORHIO does not store these documents — we are configured and authorized to retrieve these documents from outside systems and deliver them to our users.

New in 2021—Community Care Summaries—you can now query summaries from providers in the community and retrieve a consolidated 12-month view of encounters.

Accessing a Care Summary Document

1. If you have not already accessed a patient record, do this first.
2. In the menu on the left, click the Documents tab. If a pop-up message about the data range appears, follow the instructions. You may have to select All Records in the drop-down menu, then click Find External Documents button.
3. In the External Patient Discovery window, check the box for the correct patient that you want to view then click Find Patient Documents. This may take a minute as we are calling out to other systems.


