Program Update

With only a short time left to submit attestations, we urge you to have all necessary information ready prior to logging in to the Colorado Registration and Attestation (CO R&A) system. To help you prepare for the January 31, 2018 submission deadline, here are some suggestions to complete attestations.

- Have all required attachments ready in PDF format no larger than 10MB.
- Make sure payee NPI, TIN and address are updated at CMS. **Please remember that it takes 24-48 hours for CMS to complete the update.**
- The Medicaid EHR Incentive Program is a provider-based program and providers must have an individual account created in the CO R&A portal to attest in the MAPIR system.

To create an individual account, first find the login screen at www.colorado.gov/hcpf and select “Register Now.” All providers or delegates will follow these same steps to create an account (for more information about creating a delegate account, see the [October](#) issue of this newsletter).



When in the Registration Selector screen, choose “Provider” to begin the process of creating an individual account.



Next, populate the necessary information making sure to use the active Medicaid Provider ID. Because some providers had duplicate records and IDs within the interChange (Medicaid claims system), some IDs were deactivated. In this case, the Department notified all providers who had duplicate records within the interChange. To ensure your attestation is successful, **please make sure to use only the active provider ID**. If you are unsure of which Medicaid provider ID is active, please contact provider enrollment by calling (844) 235-2387.

Program Resources – Newsletter and MAPIR Page

The Medicaid EHR Incentive Program newsletter continues to be a valuable resource for informing participants on program updates and tips for success. The newsletter is sent every month through the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program coordinator. We've also made past issues available for reference on the CORHIO [Newsletter directory](#) page. Past issues contain valuable information regarding the current program year. Participants are now able to find updates, tips, FAQs and MAPIR (the new CO R&A system) errors and solutions all in one place with the new [MAPIR System Updates and EHR Incentive Program Tips](#) page. In particular, the page provides information and screenshots about known errors and how to address them.

MAPIR Highlight – Document Upload

MAPIR is currently processing many successful attestations submitted by delegates, administrators, and providers. So far, this year, the Department has received 615 successful submissions and is looking forward to issuing payments in the coming months.

The MAPIR system makes it easier to attest by allowing document upload after submitting your attestation. This is more convenient than the previous system where documents were required throughout the attestation. Simply follow the prompts to submit documents in the proper form, PDF format no larger than 10MB.

Select **Review Application** to view the information that was entered on the application that was submitted.

Navigation Keys:

- Save and Continue:** After entering your information on a screen, you must select the Save and Continue button at the bottom of each screen or the information will be lost. You may return to a screen or use the Review tab to view (or print) the saved information at any time.
- Previous:** Allows you to move to the previous screen without saving any information entered on the screen.
- Reset:** Allows you to reset the values on the current screen. If you have already saved information on the screen, the Reset button will return the data to the last saved information.
- Your MAPIR user session will end if there is no user activity after 30 minutes. You will receive timeout warnings.
- Please use the **Exit** link in the upper right hand corner of the screen to properly exit the MAPIR application and return to the portal. Use of your Internet browser exit and back / forward functions may result in unexpected results that will require you to login again.
