Program Year 2019 Update

The Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (the Department) has paid over \$3,800,500 to eligible professionals (EPs). We are pleased to report that over 460 participants have successfully attested for Program Year (PY) 2019.

Congratulations to the 33 having participants who reached payment year 6 and received their final incentive payment for their participation in the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program!

The program will remain open until June 22, 2020 and participants are encouraged to begin attesting or complete unfinished attestations. The Department understands incentive program practices may be busier than normal at this time due to the current COVID-19 pandemic and we recommend notifying the Department by email with your concerns and impacted providers no later than **June 12, 2020**.

Audit Communications

The Department contracts with Myers and Stauffer LC (MSLC) to perform pre-payment reviews and post-payment audits. Please look for communications from The Department's auditors, MSLC. These communication emails may get lost in spam, junk or clutter folders and participants should be vigilant in checking for them.

The Department completes pre-payment reviews and post-payment auditing activities. All Medicaid EHR Incentive Program attestations are reviewed prior to payment. If you have received a communication email and have any auditing questions, please contact MSLC at coloradoehr@mslc.com directly, not the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program Coordinator.

To ensure participants and auditors are communicating successfully, it is important to read emails from Myers and Stauffer in their entirety, including subject lines, and respond in a timely manner. If you need clarification or an extension to a deadline, please reach out as soon as possible. In many cases, participants may be required to update license, address, payee address, email addresses, their contract with Medicaid or change their surname within several platforms such as interChange (Medicaid Provider Portal), Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) and Department of Regulatory Agencies (DORA). Although it is important to make updates before attesting to any program year, not updating at all will result in a denial of your attestation.
