

# Two New Opportunities for Colorado

## Practices: *Facilitating Alcohol Screening and Treatment program and Innovation Support Project*



**Innovation Support Project (ISP) - 1-year program for family medicine, internal medicine, pediatric, and OB/GYN practices who serve Medicaid patients. Practices receive:**

- Practice facilitation support from the practice transformation organization of your choice
- If needed, support from a clinical health information technology advisor
- Two collaborative learning sessions per year for peer-to-peer learning and sharing
- Services of a Regional Health Connector to provide community linkages to support patient needs
- Potential CME, Maintenance of Certification, and/or COPIC points for participation
- Support to help improve Colorado Medicaid Alternative Payment Model (APM) measures

**Enrollment for July 2021 start will open in early 2020 (otherwise practices need to wait until July 1, 2022).**

**Facilitating Alcohol Screening and Treatment (FAST) - nine-month facilitated quality improvement program to address unhealthy alcohol use. Practices receive:**

- Evidence-based interventions and tracking assistance to help patients with unhealthy alcohol use
- Training for staff, medical providers and behavioral health professionals on Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment for alcohol use
- Support of a highly trained practice facilitator
- Access to experts in medical and behavioral treatments for Alcohol Use Disorder
- \$1,000 for time spent completing assessments, providing data, and research-related activities
