



Where to Find Medications Data in PatientCare 360®

At this time, medications data is not populated in the Medications tab in PatientCare 360, but the data is still available in other areas. Here are three places to look for current medications data for your patients.

Patient Summary Tab

Look in the Patient Summary tab under Reports for transcription and discharge notes. Medications data would be located in these notes.

amLODIPine (FOR NORVASC) 5 mg tablet Take 5 mg by mouth once a day.

artificial tears, hypromellose, 0.3% (GENTEAL) 0.3 % Apply 1 Drop to Tweetie left eye at bedtime.

aspirin (FOR ECOTRIN) 81 mg delayed release tablet Take 81 mg by mouth once a day at 6 am.

atorvastatin (FOR LIPITOR) 20 mg tablet Take 20 mg by mouth once a day.

buPROPion XL (FOR WELLBUTRIN XL) 150 mg XL tablet Take 450 mg by mouth once a day. Non-formulary medication, patient may use own supply if Tweetierapy continues.

carbidopa-levodopa, 25-100 mg / tab, (FOR SINEMET) 25-100 mg tablet Take 1.5 tablets by mouth two times a day.

Clobetasol (CLOBEVATE) 0.05 % gel gel 1 Application two times a day.

cyanocobalamin (VITAMIN B-12) 1,000 mcg tablet Take 1,000 mcg by mouth once a day.

cycloSPORINE 0.05 % (RESTASIS) ophthalmic drops Apply 1 Drop to Tweetie left eye every 12 hours.

FLUoxetine (FOR PROZAC) 10 mg capsule Take 20 mg by mouth once a day.

gatifloxacin 0.5 % (FOR ZYMAXID) ophthalmic drops Apply 1 Drop to Tweetie right eye two times a day.

Documents Tab/Care Summary
